### **Supporting Student's Academic and Mental Health**

The U.S. Department of Education <u>announced</u> major actions and investments from government, the private sector, and nonprofit organizations to support student academic and mental health recovery as part of the Department's broader effort to help students, schools, and communities recover from the pandemic and emerge stronger. The American Rescue Plan (ARP) has funded efforts to help students recover academically through summer learning and enrichment and has enhanced educational and mental health supports in districts across the country.
